## Isosorbide shortages prompt a reaction

Shortages of all strengths of normal-release isosorbide mononitrate tablets have become so acute in the UK that the government's chief pharmaceutical officer, Dr Keith Rudge, has written to pharmacists. "Problems with the availability of raw materials", he says, mean normal supplies are "unlikely to resume before the end of April 2013".

He recommends substitution with a slow-release mononitrate of the same strength. Community pharmacists who are unable to obtain stock, but are presented with a prescription for normal-release tablets, are advised to refer patients back to their prescriber. "Where the prescriber intends for an unlicensed product to be supplied, the prescription will need to be written in a way that makes this clear," says Rudge, noting that companies are "importing unlicensed isosorbide mononitrate for use on an individual patient basis".

Surprisingly, however, only the isosorbide 10mg strength was granted 'no cheaper stock obtainable' (NCSO) status by the Department of Health in February, despite all three strengths being in short supply, according to Rudge, and as evidenced by Figure 3. Indapamide 2.5mg tablets and trazadone 50mg,100mg and 150mg capsules were also granted NCSO status, which means pharmacists are may be reimbursed for dispensing a more expensive alternative. Temazepam 10mg and 20mg in 28-tablet packs were granted price concessions of £24 (US\$36.34) and £25, respectively.

Meanwhile, average prices for donepezil 10mg, mirtazapine 45mg and risperidone 2mg all had double-digit rises last month (see Figure 1). These were offset, however, by average prices for ibandronic acid 50mg dropping by almost a third (see Figure 2).
