Drug Tariff makes mark on current prices

ategory M of the Drug Tariff fixes the reimbursement prices for retail pharmacists and dispensing doctors using quarterly volume-weighted market prices. What is less clear, however, is how changes in these Drug Tariff prices, based on historical data up to six months old, affect current prices of generics in the marketplace.

In theory, there is no connection. But in practice there may be. Take levothyroxine, for example. In the latest October Drug Tariff, the reimbursement prices for 28-tablet packs of levothyroxine 50µg and 100µg both fell to £1.22 (US\$2.28). In the former case, this represented a drop of about 12%, but in the latter it was just £0.01.

In contrast, the Drug Tariff price of levothyroxine 25µg rose by

16% to £1.37. The effect on market prices was immediate. Average prices went up by 36% to £0.56 in the following month, and the lowest price increased by 9% to £0.24. This gave the product the biggest price rise in October (see Figure 3).

But as Figure 2 shows, the two levothyroxine products that were reimbursed at a lower price in October saw their value in the market decrease, making them the biggest fallers in the month. The only surprise was that the price of the 100µg product suffered more.

Bargains were to be had in ciprofloxacin, lamotrigine and ramipril (see Figure 1). Lansoprazole prices were down across the board, but carvedilol offered bargains in a generally rising market.
